BOARD COMMITTEES

Standing committees may be created and deleted by the Board President, subject to approval of the Board. The Board President shall be an ex-officio member of all committees.

Committees shall have no power to take action whatsoever, or to commit the Board or district to any course of action, except as specifically directed by the Board. They may act only in an investigator and advisory capacity. All committee recommendations must be acted upon by the Board.

The Board shall authorize such special committees as deemed necessary.

Meeting dates and agendas may be set and jointly developed by the Superintendent and committee chair.

Public notice shall be given for all Board committee meetings in accordance with state law and established procedures and minutes taken.
