Policy 351

SUMMER SCHOOL

The School District of West Salem may offer students an opportunity to participate in summer school programs when there is enough student interest and available funds.

All summer school programs must have the approval of the district administrator and Board. The purpose of summer school shall be for enrichment, remediation and the make up of academic courses required for graduation. Courses offered in summer school shall be based on the needs and interests of the students.

Enrollment in summer school shall be strictly voluntary. However, students enrolling in summer school shall be expected to be in attendance for at least 80 percent of the time their regularly-scheduled classes meet. Time in individualized types of instruction, such as drama and music, shall be computed directly from the instructor's records.

Summer school shall be operated in accordance with state aid provisions outlined in state law.
