GUIDANCE PROGRAM

The guidance and counseling program of the School District of West Salem shall provide services to students, staff, parents/guardians and the community to facilitate the basic goals of the Wisconsin Developmental Guidance Program.

The program shall provide a developmentally-based structure in grades kindergarten through 12 that allows students to master the various competencies essential to their total growth.

Building principals and guidance counselors shall be responsible for the screening of all new students, the maintenance of student records, the testing program and student scheduling.

The School District of West Salem shall not discriminate in the methods, practices and materials used for counseling, evaluating and testing students on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
