

INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS

It is the goal of the West Salem High School athletic program to help students develop the skills necessary to become competitive in interscholastic activities. The Board believes limiting team size shall provide a realistic opportunity for athletes to develop the skills and playing time necessary to be competitive in interscholastic competition.

It is the goal of the middle school to encourage participation and skill development in all co-curricular activities. Consequently, sporting seasons shall be shortened to allow for the exploration of other co-curricular activities.

The high school athletic programs shall function under district and Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association (WIAA) guidelines.

The School District of West Salem shall not discriminate in student participation in athletic programs or activities, standards and rules of behavior, disciplinary actions or facilities usage on the basis of gender, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, economic status, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
