WISCONSIN ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE

In the event two or more candidates have the same grade point average, the following tie-breaking procedure shall be followed until there is no longer a tie:

- 1. The student who shows evidence of application to a participating Wisconsin institution by the beginning date of the eighth semester shall be the designee.
- 2. The student with the highest composite American College Test (ACT) score available as of the beginning date of the eighth semester shall be the designee.
- 3. The student with the most credits earned through seven semesters shall be the designee.
- 4. The student selected following a transcript analysis shall be the designee. The transcript analysis shall include an evaluation of courses for post-secondary preparation and the appropriateness of courses for the intended field of study.
- 5. A coin flip shall determine the designee.
