## Printed Sources

### Books

Author. *Title*. Place of Publication: Publisher, Date. Print.

Dolan, Edward F. *Drugs in Sports*. New York: Franklin Watts, 2002. Print.

*More than one author:*

Rowe, William, and Vivian Schelling. *Memory and Modernity*. New York: Routledge Chapman & Hall, 2001. Print.

*More than 3 authors*

Quirk, Randolph, et al. *A Comprehensive Grammar of the English Language*. London: Longman, 1985. Print.

### Encyclopedias

Author. "Title of Article." *Name of Encyclopedia Series*. Year of edition. Print.

Note: Start with "Title" if no author given

Holzer, Harold. "Lincoln, Abraham." *World Book Encyclopedia*. 2012 ed. Print.

### Magazine or Newspaper Articles (from actual magazines, not online)

*Signed (with author):*

Author. "Title of Article." *Name of Magazine or Newspaper*. Date: page number. Print.

Campbell, Susan. "We Are So Very Different." *Time*. 1 Dec. 2008: 58. Print.

*Unsigned (no author):*

"Title of Article." *Magazine*. Date: page number. Print.

"Over the Edge." *Sports Illustrated*. May 2009: 62-70. Print.

### Interviews

Name of Person Interviewed. Kind of Interview. Date.

Goodwin, John. Personal interview. 24 Feb. 2012.

Kohl, Herb. Telephone interviews. 8-12 May 2012.

### E-Mail

Name of writer. "Subject of Message." Description of message. Date of message. E-mail.

Harner, James. "Re: Senior Exit Project." Message to the author. 10 Feb. 2012. E-mail.

## Online Sources

### Internet Sources

Author's name (last name first). "Title." *Title of Overall Website*. Publisher or sponsor of site (if none, use N.p), Date updated (if nothing use n.d.). Web. Date of access. <URL>.

### Encyclopedia – Online

Author's name (last name first). "Title." *Name of Online Encyclopedia*.

Sponsor of site, Publication year. Web. Date accessed. <url>.

### Magazine and Newspaper Articles from Databases

Author, if given. "Title of Article." *Name of Magazine or Newspaper*. Date: page. *Name of Database*. Web. Date accessed. <url>.

If no page is given, use n.pag.

### Book from Database

Author. "Title of Section." *Book*. Place of publication: Publisher, Date. *Name of Database*. Web. Date accessed. <url>.
