About Sara: Sara Rose Hougom was a beautiful, young woman whose life was violently taken at the age of 20 in March of 2012. Originally from West Salem, she lived in La Crosse for three years while attending Western Technical College and also working as a waitress at Manny's. She was also involved with dance all her life. Sara was full of life and energy that she spread to everyone she was around. She was fun, vibrant, and outgoing, but words cannot describe how special of a person Sara was to her family and friends.



With the increase in violent behavior in the La Crosse community, Sara's family and friends feel that now is the time to spread more awareness through the Sara Rose Hougom Foundation to West Salem where Sara graduated in 2009. Careless acts of violence and vandalism have affected hundreds of area families. With this in mind we created this scholarship in her memory.

PURPOSE: To financially assist one graduating senior at West Salem High School for a major in Law Enforcement, Fire Fighting or other Public Service degree.

CRITERIA: The recipient must be accepted for enrollment in a college, university, or technical school program with a major focusing on Law Enforcement, Fire Fighting or Public Service. Preference will be given to students who have been actively involved in the community, hold at least a B average and show a passion for this field. This is a two year scholarship, if pending a satisfactory GPA.

PROCESS: The recipient will be selected by members of the Sara Rose Hougom Foundation Board with special consideration given to a student who has a passion for their field and has a financial need for the scholarship. Applications are due no later than March 31, 2024 and should be sent to:
