NOTES FROM THE SCHOOL NURSE

When to Keep Your Child Home:

- Fever: greater than 100 degrees. For fever and flu symptoms, a student should not return to school until the fever has been gone for 24 hours without the use of medication
- Vomiting: return 24 hours after vomiting stops
- Diarrhea: return 24 hours after diarrhea stops
- Rash: rash that is open and draining or a rash with a fever
- Contagious Diseases: (strep throat, impetigo, pink eye) A student may return after 24 hours of treatment with antibiotic
- Nuisance Diseases: head lice, scabies, ringworm must be treated before returning to school
- Chicken Pox: child may return to school 5-7 days after onset of rash, with all sores dry and scabbed over

Please notify you child's school if your child is absent due to illness or injury.

If Your Child is Injured at School

When your child is injured: If your child is injured and requires any type of modification to the school day, a physician's note listing those modifications is required. Students must attend Physical Education and recess unless a physician specially excuses them from those activities. The physician may fax these modifications to the school. Fax number at the Elementary school is 608-786-3415.

Illness or Injury at School: Students who become ill or injured at school will be seen in the health office by trained staff. If your child is unable to return to class, a parent will be contacted. For you child's comfort, please make arrangements to pick them up as soon as possible.
