Report cards will be going home with students on Wednesday, December 13th. Please take time to review and go over your child's report card with them. This is a great learning opportunity for you and your child as well. The report card is another way we communicate student growth and progress during the year. By seeing how your child grows from trimester to trimester is what we are also looking at here at WSES. Remembering that starting strong is good, but finishing strong is what we all are striving for! With the winter months upon us and snow right around the corner we offer a few reminders. Please have your child dressed for the weather on a daily basis. Our students will be outside for recess unless the temperature is below a real feel temperature of ten degrees. Please make sure to send your child with hats, mittens, boots, snow pants, and winter coats. Also please take time to label your child's items with initials or last name.

Staying on our expectations for recess, we would like to remind families and students of the following:

- Students are not allowed to use technology outside. This includes school iPads and personal items, such as cell phones.
- Students may bring outside toys, such as footballs, basketballs, etc, but should not bring toys used for inside.
- If a student brings a ball of some type from home, please let them know that they need to hang onto while bringing it back in the building. There has been quite a bit of playing catch in line after the bell.
- Students have been bringing whistles onto the playground and using them, please let students know they should not have whistles.

I am asking that we use extra caution when dropping off and picking up your child. When the snow begins to fall the sidewalk and parking lots may become slippery. Please make sure to slow down, look, and take a few extra minutes for the safety of all. If you drop your child off in the morning on either the North or South lot, please make sure to pull up to the sidewalk and let your child off on the sidewalk side. Out of courtesy of others, please do not park or get out of your vehicle. The safety of all of our children is so important, and with the parking lots being full due to construction at the middle school, ensuring a safe drop off is essential. Thank you for your cooperation!

We all want to make sure that we keep our children safe. Safety for our children isn't just with their peers, but also with the electronic devices that they use. Our children have so much available to them at the touch of their fingertips, and often curiosity can and will expose our children to content that is not age appropriate. As a school, we do periodic checks of students history on their iPads, but we also encourage this at home. Urgent: Tooth Bags Needed!!


The Elementary School provides tooth bags for students who lose a tooth at school. If you have any extra material and could sew a few tooth bags, the Elementary
