January is a busy month with the preparations for an all school assembly to celebrate our student accomplishments and focus on our positive behavior system. Students will be taking mid year assessments as we continue to use data to ensure we are doing our best for our students.


Just some reminders as we move into the new year about entry into our building:

- 1. Students are to be dropped off after 7:30 am for the breakfast program. We have limited staff on hand to accommodate early bus riders, but general supervision and breakfast begin at 7:30 am. We have had some issues with students getting dropped off prior to this.
- 2. Please observe the following if you choose to drop-off in either elementary parking lot.
 - 1. Arrive at school prior to 8:00 a.m.
 - 2. Drive at a slow speed and observe signs.
 - 3. Watch carefully for students or staff who may be crossing the parking lot.
 - 4. Pull as far forward as possible to ease traffic congestion. It's okay for your child to walk a little extra distance so that you do not back up traffic flow.
 - 5. If a car has not pulled forward and there is space ahead, please pass slowly and move as far forward as possible.
 - 6. Pull over to the sidewalk to drop off, staying in a single line of traffic. Forming a second line puts students at risk, as they must cross traffic to reach the sidewalk.
 - 7. Children should be ready to exit the vehicle when dropping off. Have backpacks on laps, ready to get out of the car quickly, so those behind you do not need to wait.
 - 8. Children should exit the vehicle on the passenger side to avoid moving traffic.
 - 9. Do not leave your car for any reason. If you need to come in the building, or walk your child to the playground, park in a **designated parking space**.
 - 10. The front loop is for buses only until 8:00 a.m. and then closes for buses at the conclusion of the day from 2:50 until 3:45 p.m.
 - 11. When leaving our parking lots to help with the congestion, we encourage parents to turn left out of our South lot and turn right out of our North lot. This will help the flow of traffic and help to alleviate backing up in our lots.
- 3. Kindly remember that all entry into our building should be through our main office. This is not to hinder parent participation in our school, but it helps to ensure the safety of our students and staff throughout our building.

Speaking of safety, with the cold temperatures of winter, please make sure that coats, boots, snow pants, hats, and mittens/gloves are sent with your child each day. I

encourage all families to label their clothing. We have an ever growing "Lost and Found" section, and labeling of clothing would help a great deal in returning items to the proper child.

Kindergarten Registration 2018-2019

Now that West Salem has a 4-Year-Old Kindergarten program in place, we will no longer be hosting a <u>kindergarten</u> registration. If you have a student who will be five years old by September 1, 2018 and your child does not attend our 4K program, please contact the elementary school office at 786-1662 to preregister.

All current 4K students will automatically receive a kindergarten packet.

Just a reminder that students should have a change of clothing that is appropriate for the season at school especially for our lower grades. If you have borrowed clothing from the nurse's office, please wash and return it.

If anyone has any gently used pants and/or underwear that their child has out grown, we are in need of boys and girls sizes 5-8.

Please send snow pants, hat and mittens daily with your children. They will be outside daily if weather permits. Extra gloves and hats packed in backpack would be a great idea for those sloppy wet snowy days.

Four-Year-Old Kindergarten Registration Screening

Mark your calendars now...

If you have a child who will be four years old by September 1, 2018, please call the Elementary Office to register your child.

You will receive a packet in the mail prior to the event.

Then plan on attending either Tuesday, January 16th (for last names that start with A-L) or Tuesday, January 23rd (for names that start with M-Z) with your child.

Please come by 6:00pm to sign in and transition your child to a classroom for a variety of activities

led by one of our 4K teachers. Social, communication, motor and early learning skills will be observed. An audiologist will be on hand for free hearing screenings by parent request. Handouts regarding various aspects of child development will be available to families. The parent registration meeting will be held in the assembly room at 6:30pm. The total time needed for the various activities will be approximately one hour 15 minutes. Please allow extra time if a hearing screening is requested.

Please note that registration cannot be completed without residency and birth certificate verification.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

School starts at 8:00 a.m. Children enter the building at this time and then the doors are locked immediately for security reasons. Children who arrive after this time need to enter through the main office for a tardy pass.


