

Medication Information

Please give medications at home whenever possible. However, if medication is needed during the school day, the following is necessary:

- Pink medication forms are available at your school or local clinic. Your doctor may also fax the medication form to the school. Fax number: 608-786-3415
- Students may not carry or keep their own medication at school with the exception of prescription inhalers with a doctor's written permission.
- Parents/guardians are requested to please deliver medication to the school office.
- A new medication form is needed each time the medication is changed.

Prescription Medication - Drugs that your child's physician prescribes

A medication form must be on file for each medication with the following requirements:

- A doctor's signature with written instruction for the medication including medication name, dose and time to be given.
- Written consent from the parent for the school to give the medication.
- Medications must be in a properly labeled prescription bottle.

Non-Prescription Medication - Drugs that is readily available to the public without a prescription that are safe to use without the advice of a physician

- Written consent from the parent with instructions for the school to give the medication.
- Medication must be in the original container.
