SCHOOL DISTRICT LEGAL STATUS

The legal basis for education in the School District of West Salem is vested in the will of the people as expressed in the Wisconsin Constitution and the state statutes pertaining to the education and court interpretation of the validation of the laws and powers implied under them.

The official name of this school district is the School District of West Salem. It is organized as a common school district and includes the towns of Bangor, Barre, Burns, Farmington, Greenfield, Hamilton, Medary, Shelby and Washington and the village of West Salem, all in La Crosse County.
