

SCHOOL BOARD LEGAL STATUS

The Board derives its authority to govern the School District of West Salem directly from the Wisconsin Constitution and the state statutes. The Board shall act as an agent of the state in developing an educational program in accordance with laws governing public education and common school districts.

Number of Board Members

The Board shall consist of seven members (a president, a vice president, a clerk, a treasurer and three directors).

Terms of Office

Board members shall serve for a term of three years except as otherwise provided.
