

QUORUM

A majority of the elected membership of the Board constitutes a quorum at a regular or special meeting.

When a quorum is present, a majority vote of those members physically and/or electronically present shall be legally binding, except as otherwise provided by state law or Board policy. In the absence of a quorum, the only official action that the Board may take is to adjourn the meeting to another time and/or date.
