

CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

The Board has a responsibility for maintaining a program of instruction aligned to the Wisconsin Model Academic and for ensuring that an ongoing cycle of review and enhancements is completed.

The Curriculum Coordinator shall, with the assistance of building principals and instructional coaches delegate responsibility for proposing and developing curriculum changes and additions to instructional staff. Communication and coordination among and between grade level and subject area teachers should be emphasized on a kindergarten through grade 12 basis whenever curriculum is developed. Curriculum Committees need to meet in a regular ongoing manner.

All course offerings and any additions or deletions to the curriculum shall be reviewed at least on a 5-year cycle and adopted by the Board before they are initiated or dropped from the existing program of instruction.
