INSTRUCTION

The Board supports the following instructional goals for the School District of West Salem:

1. A well-coordinated, integrated, instructional program shall be made available for students at all grade levels and shall be under the direction of the district Curriculum Director and department in conjunction with the building administrators.
2. Adequate time and effort shall be devoted to instruction in the basic skill areas.
3. A variety of learning materials, tools, and teaching techniques shall be used to accommodate individual student ability and achievement to ensure that each student is provided with the opportunity, knowledge, and practice to use and process information to each his or her fullest potential.
4. Parents/guardians should be involved in cooperative efforts to help each student reach his/her potential.
5. The instructional program and student achievement shall be evaluated annually and results reported to the parent and / or guardian, School Board and Community.
6. The faculty shall be provided with opportunities to enhance instructional skills through on site and off site educational experiences.
