TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE

In the event two or more candidates have the same grade point average, the following tie-breaking procedure shall be followed until there is no longer a tie:

1. The student who shows evidence of application to a participating Wisconsin institution by the beginning date of the eighth semester shall be the designee.
2. The student with the highest composite American College Test (ACT) score available as of the beginning date of the eighth semester shall be the designee.
3. The student with the most credits earned through seven semesters shall be the designee.
4. The student selected following a transcript analysis shall be the designee. The transcript analysis shall include an evaluation of courses for post-secondary preparation and the appropriateness of courses for the intended field of study.
5. A coin flip shall determine the designee.
