

STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

Bus riders shall conform to the same standards of conduct which are expected of them at school and bus ridership rules.

When a student fails to conduct him/herself in accordance with established school conduct and bus ridership rules, the bus driver shall bring such misconduct to the appropriate administrator's and transportation director's attention by completing a bus disciplinary form. Notification of parents/guardians and due process shall be in accordance with established Board policy.

Bus Rider Rules and Disciplinary Action Procedures will be posted in each bus and school handbook. They will be reviewed annually by the administrative team in April.
