West Salem 4K Program

Eligible:

Children must be residents or open enrolled and be four years old by September 1, **2022**.

Program Sessions (proposed)

West Salem Elementary School, 3 morning sessions and 3 afternoon sessions.

NOTE: We will do our best to accommodate all requests, however, when students use our bus service, we will place them in a section that is most efficient for the bus schedule to keep ride times as short as possible.

Days/Time

143 school days (Must have 437 hours and 87.5 outreach hours)

Class

3 hours and 10 minutes daily

Morning session 8:30-11:40am - Monday-Thursday with students

Afternoon session Noon-3:10pm - Monday-Thursday with students

Friday: Teacher planning and outreach activities which typically involve direct services to parents home visits, parent meetings at school, parent education classes, parent-child activities, family resource center visits and participation in parent advisory committees.

Staffing

Wisconsin DPI Licensure: teachers of 4K students must hold a pre-kindergarten or kindergarten license. A paraprofessional is with each class.

Student Ratio

15-18 students per session

Curriculum

Creative Curriculum will be used in all sections and sites

Transportation

Students will be provided transportation in accordance with the district's overall transportation policies.
