

BUS ROUTING AND SCHEDULING

The Director of Transportation shall establish bus routes and schedules for the district. The length of time any one child would be required to remain on the bus, proximity of bus stops to students' residences, safe practice in bus operation, school schedules and other factors ensuring safety and reasonableness of operation shall be used to determine the routing of each bus and the location of pick-up and discharge points.

School buses shall not travel on private roads unless the road OR drive way is used as a turn around by written permission from the land owner, the bus serves special needs students, 4-year-old kindergarten routes, or as directed by the school board. All roads traveled must be maintained and accessible by a school bus; free from hazards, and obstructions which may cause damage to the bus.

Any damage to the private road caused by vehicle travel is not the responsibility of the district.

Bus routes and schedules shall be approved annually by the Board of Education.
