In this month's feed we decided to interview the one and only, Nick Miller.



Tell us a little bit about yourself: "I grew up on a farm right outside of West Salem and graduated from West Salem High School in 1998. I graduated from UW-L with a degree in Management in 2001 and bought Le Coulee Cheese Castle in June of 2003. After graduating from college, I began searching for a job in the area and discovered that the owners of Le Coulee Cheese were thinking of retiring. So in June of 2003, I purchased the

building and business. I had great memories of this business so I didn't want to see it close."

What is your favorite ice cream flavor?: "My favorite flavor of ice cream is anything with caramel."

What does a typical day look like?: "A typical day at the Cheese Castle starts at 7am with completing any orders that are to be picked up that day. After those are completed, I cut and package cheese, fill ice cream containers, stock products and help customers who stop in. I close at 5:00 each day and typically have about 1 and 1/2 hours of cleanup."

Have you had any other previous jobs?:"I previously worked on my parent's dairy farm while attending school."

What do you like to do outside of work?: "Outside of work, I spend my time working in my yard, helping my parents on the farm, or spending time with family and friends."






What is Thanksgiving?

The best time to hunt elk is the morning and evening hours.



Ice fishermen may fish in the open or in heated enclosures, some with bunks and amenities. In Wisconsin, bluegill, perch, walleye, bass, crappie and northern pike are the most sought after species in winter. Bluegill and perch are the most commonly caught. Minnows are preferred bait for many of the fish listed. Around West Salem, most people ice fish on Lake Neshonoc..



How Safe Is Your Sport?

Do you know how safe your favorite sport is? I'm going to talk about different sports and the most common injuries that can happen while playing them.

I'll start with soccer, which I know many West Salem students play and enjoy. The most common injury is in the ankle. Many sprains can happen when you turn your foot inward while dribbling the ball or while running. Luckily an ankle sprain can heal, but it can take up to three weeks if you do follow the proper instructions of your doctor.

Next, I'll talk about gymnastics, which happens to be my favorite sport. In gymnastics it is very common to damage your ACL, or another very common injury is tearing your achilles tendon. A torn achilles tendon can heal, but it will take weeks to heal. Your ACL, though, almost always needs surgery to repair.

Cross Country is another very popular sport at West Salem. Since there is constant running in the sport, it is very common to have shin splints which is a constant throbbing pain in the shins caused by the pounding while running. Shin splints heal with the right amount of time to rest your legs. Runner's knee is another very common injury in cross country. This is where the cartilage of the knee gets worn down because of constant use. The good news is runner's knee does heal with proper care.

The final sport that I will be mentioning today is basketball. The most common injuries in basketball are in the ankle and hip. Ankle injuries happen most often when rolling the ankle, or even getting stepped on by another player. You can injure your hip by lots of pivoting, rebounding, and more.


