

Did you know that you can track your child's food service purchases in Skyward Family Access?

Just select the "Food Service" tab.

















Did you ever wonder why you are receiving low or negative food service balance notifications or wonder how to manage them?

An automated phone/email messaging system will begin sending messages, Monday - Friday, to all parents/guardians associated with any child on the food service account when the

account falls below \$10.00 (normal price)/\$3.00 (reduced price)/\$0.00 (free).

If you are not the payor on the food service account and wish to not receive these messages, here are the steps you can take.

- Login to Skyward Family Access. (If parents or guardians do not have access to Family Access, they can request their user id and password from the building secretary.)
- 2. Select the student you would like to manage notifications for and go to the **Skylert** tab.
- 3. Make adjustments to what is checked in the **Food Service** column.
- 4. Click on Save.
