Our district's score of 77.3, which is an increase of 4 points from last year, earned the designation of Exceeds Expectations. We celebrate the fact that all of our schools improved on their scores from last year, and our elementary school is the top scoring non-charter elementary school in La Crosse County. These results are based on state-mandated assessments, as well as key indicators such as attendance, dropout rates, and students on track for graduation.

REFERENDUM PROJECT UPDATES

What is Happening with the Construction Projects?



As we wrap up the year, our District is proud to share progress on both the Elementary and High School construction projects. December is a time to reflect on student and District milestones reached and look ahead to the facility improvements that will continue shaping our students, staff, and community in the new year.

Elementary School

The project is approximately 7.5% completed thus far. Soil corrections for concrete footings and slab have successfully finished. Crews are now focused on concrete footings and foundations laying groundwork and framework for the elementary gym addition.

Work Upcoming

Looking ahead, several key activities are scheduled in the coming weeks:

- » Installation of the underground storm sewer
- » Placement of foundation insulation
- » Installation of drain tile
- » Backfilling footings and foundations
- » Erection of structural steel columns and beams
- » Construction of the CMU fire wall
- » Site utilities

High School

To stay up to date on the current project site, the District and KA have set up a time-lapse camera to catch all day-to-day updates on site. This is located on the District webpage which can be found at bit.ly/WSconstruction. We are excited to start to see dirt moving at the High School site.
