

4K Online Schedule

We appreciate your patience and flexibility on this journey! Remember, we are in an ever changing situation and nothing is set in stone. We promise to communicate as quickly and often as we can as changes are presented to us. This is a guide for a *typical online 4K school day*. Each teacher will follow the same subject matter and outline, but there will be some differences to allow for the individuality of each child, each class, and each teacher.

- Please plan for your child to interact with his or her class and teacher during their normal class hours (AM classes = 8:30AM - 11:40 PM, PM classes = 12:00 - 3:00PM)
- Class Zoom details:
 - Morning Meeting with the entire class will be live and recorded during your regular school hours. Question or Theme of the Day will be the topics of conversation during Class Zoom meetings. It will be the same time each day to remain consistent for families to build the routine of our school day. If your child cannot participate in the live zoom, we are working on how these meetings will be recorded so your child can listen and watch. We also encourage your child to send a voice message through SeeSaw to the teacher responding to the Question or Theme of the Day if they cannot participate live. This will be written in our Weekly Communication so that families can have children prepared for the meeting.
- Individual Zoom meeting details:
 - Teachers will meet individually with students 1 day per week to build rapport and relationships with the students. The conversations will be about 5-10 minutes. The topics of conversations will be guided by what your child chooses to talk

about and will also work one on one with basic academic skills like counting, letters in their name, and colors. You will receive a Google doc in your e-mail to sign up for a designated time. Our hope is to meet with each child at the same day and time during regular school hours. We are flexible, but please be respectful and understand that your child's teacher has an average 15 zoom calls to schedule.

- Weekly thematic activities:
 - Each week you will receive a newsletter via SeeSaw app. The newsletter will include at least 10 activities your child can participate in at home with family members. These 10 activities follow our classroom play areas. Examples include sensory ideas, books to read, building ideas (blocks, legos, sticks) writing activities, cooking suggestions, math games, and outdoor play suggestions. We suggest that you complete 2-3 of these activities each day or work on these activities for 1-1.5 hours per day, 4 days per week.
- Instructional videos:
 - Your child's teacher will send one instructional video each week where she demonstrates how to use new art supplies, builds a thought provoking structure, or demonstrates an exploration activity. The goal is to get your child to learn through play.
 - Your child's teacher will also send one instructional video each week where she demonstrates a 3 step craft or following directions project. The materials will be delivered to your home once every two weeks (depending on anticipated length of time for online learning) to complete these crafts. Please post a photo of your child's completed project on SeeSaw!
- Early Years Newsletters and Family Outreach:
 - Your family will receive monthly newsletters from the subscription of "Early Years". We will also be providing monthly activities for family outreach activities.
- Books:
 - We will provide monthly Scholastic book order information. Your child's teacher will communicate with you how to purchase books from the Scholastic Book Club website.
 - We will provide a free book each month for your child to read and enjoy at home.
