## HANDBOOK AND REGISTRATION INFORMATION

The West Salem School District's summer school program will be held July 22 – August 9, 2019 from 8:30-11:35am, and is available to all public and parochial school students who reside within the school district.

**Students in grades 3 – 4 (incoming)** will be able to attend three, 50-minute classes during this three week program. Class choices include both enrichment classes and intervention classes; however, intervention classes are by invitation only. Classes will be held at the elementary school.

## **Busing Information**

Buses will be assigned to designated areas/stops for summer school. Buses will **unload** students in the **front loop** at the elementary school and buses will **load** in the **bus loading zone** at the elementary school. Buses will be dismissed at 11:45. See information enclosed from the transportation department and contact Monica Quinn at the District Office at 786-0700 with questions regarding bus transportation. \*There is no busing during June and July swimming lessons.

## Student Drop Off and Pick UP

Students may be dropped off and picked up at the elementary school in the south (kindergarten wing) or north (gym side) parking lots. Drivers need to be very alert to children exiting vehicles. Please drive slowly. The front loop at the elementary is for buses only until 8:30 a.m. or if buses are present.

## Student Safety

Students walking to and from school should stay on designated routes determined by parents, and students should use the assistance of crossing guards when available. Students must go directly home or to their designated location right after summer school dismissal.

#### Student Arrival

On the first day of summer school, students will meet his/her teacher in the multi-purpose room **at the beginning of each class. On the second day** of summer school, and there after, students will go to his/her class when the bell rings. \*\*Please have your child bring his/her schedule, either printed or written, from home.

## **Inclement Weather**

When the flag is out it means that students will be inside due to weather conditions and **students will** report to the following locations:

#### **Start Time**

The bell rings at 8:25 for students to report to his/her first class. Students should bring his/her summer school schedule with them the first several days of summer school or until it is no longer needed.

#### Absences

If your child will be absent from summer school, please call the Elementary School Office (grades K-4) at 786-1662 by 9:00 a.m.

# Snack/Break

Students may choose to purchase a school prepared snack during the break using his/her 4-digit lunch number or by paying with cash. Free and reduced rates apply for this snack for those who qualify. Students may also bring his/her own snack from home. Cost of school prepared snack is approximately \$1.65 for full price and Free for all Free or Reduced kids. You **MUST** have money in your lunch account. There will be no charging allowed. Ice Cream and other ala carte items (not sold for kindergarten) will be available for approximately \$1.00 each **(cash only)**. Milk will be available for \$0.50.

## **Class Fees**

Class fees should be paid **on the first day of summer school**. Make checks payable to West Salem Summer School and return to the elementary school. **Please do not send money at this time**.

#### Student Behavior

It is expected that all students behave in a respectful, responsible, and safe manner while attending summer school. Misbehavior may result in a student not being allowed to attend summer school.

## Registration

Students who currently attend a School District of West Salem public school will register online. Online registration will begin April 23 via Skyward Family Access (please refer to the attached online registration letter for directions). ## **Final Schedules**
