Immunizations

The law requires students through grade 12 to be immunized according to their age/grade by the beginning of the school year.

Immunization is a shared responsibility. Parents are required to have their children immunized in accordance with state law and to keep accurate records. If a student is unable to receive immunizations for medical, religious or personal conviction reasons, a waiver must be signed.

In compliance with the state law, schools are required to keep records and review them annually. (s. 252.04 Wis. Stats.).

When students do not meet the requirements of the law: 1.) Parents are notified by a legal notice. 2.) If the student is not in compliance after receiving the legal notice, the district attorney is notified.

Please notify your child's school each time your child receives an immunization
