As part of on-going Child-Find efforts our district will be hosting free developmental screening clinics at West Salem Elementary School. We will be using the Ages and Stages online questionnaire, paired with inperson screening sessions. Early Childhood staff and a speech therapist will be available to interact with your child while looking for specific developmental milestones.
