



What Gear You Need:

- Warm clothes
- Tackle gear
- A pole
- An auger
- A sled
- tip/ups
- Fishing license
- Maybe food/water









Safety:

- 1. Share your fishing plans.
- 2. Don't fish alone.
- 3. Talk to the locals (about ice thickness & possible hazards).
- 4. Follow ice thickness guidelines (see below).
- 5. Use a flotation suit.
- 6. Carry a pair of ice picks/rescue claws.
- 7. Carry a throw rope.
- 8. Leave the lake before dark.
- 9. Install proper ventilation.
- 11. Respect the ice auger.
- 12. Stay hydrated.
- 10. Bring a portable power bank battery charger.
- 13. Layer up.

Ice thickness guidelines:

2" or less - STAY OFF!

4" - Ice fishing or other activities on foot

5" - Snowmobile or ATV

8" - 12" - Car or small pickup

12" - 15" - Medium truck

Bluegill. The best bait to use is wax worms, small plastics, and red spikes.

Yellow Perch. The best bait to use is small minnows, small plastics, wax worms, and small spoon baits.

Crappie. The best bait is small minnows, small plastics, crappie nuggets, and fake minnow lures.

Northern Pike. The best bait is hot dogs and small Bluegill and big spoon baits.

2022 World Cup


