Each year at this time I am reminded of advice offered by Steven Covey, author of The Seven Habits of Highly Effective People, and many other books on leadership and personal success. Covey asserts that change happens not by breaking old habits but by making new and better habits. He also offers that research indicates it takes the average person 21 days to make a new habit. The following example highlights Covey's advice. Resolving to lose weight or to stop eating sugar focuses on negative behaviors and rarely produces the desired result. A better option may be resolving to "move more and eat better" followed by keeping track of your exercise and diet for 21 days. Chances are you will make a few small changes that will result in better health and maybe fewer pounds.

This is a great thing to do with your children. Set aside some time in January to make some positive goals. Keep track of their progress with a fun 21-day chart, and celebrate the creation of new positive habits. Think of small meaningful changes to allow for success. Things like cleaning up after play, getting ready for school, reading, or cooperating with others. It might also be fun to set goals for yourself and share your progress as a way of modeling the creation of new and better habits. Everyone can get better at "getting better."
