



- Out of 87 students 11 said they typically drink less than 16oz a day.
- Out of 88 students 36 said they carry a water bottle with them everyday.
- Out of 88 students 76 said they think drinking water is important.
- Out of 88 students 1 said that they think drinking water is not important.



Marble League Making a Smashing Hit

MarbleLympics is a marble competition on youtube created by Jelle and Dion Bakker. They set up an event (like a track under water), and different marble teams duke it out in the different events/tracks. So far, it's been a smashing hit. Jelle makes it seem like a 3DBotMaker and creates the illusion that we are watching this like an actual sport. It shows the marbles as athletes training for the event.

The MableLympics of last year got 136 million views! In 2015, Jelle's marble run created the following teams: Momary, Team Primary, Bumblebees, Limers, Shining Swarm, Minty Maniacs, Hobalts, and Gliding Glaciers. Snowballers is a team that was made at the beginning of MarbleLympics.

In 2015, Snowballers landed 14 overall and did poorly in the MarbleLympics. The officials discovered that there was a defect in the Snowballer's lane, and thus they got a "consolation bronze" and got an extra five points.

Minty Maniacs were the cream of the crop for 2016 and 2018. After a brief period of retirement, they appeared for the Marble League Showdown of 2019 and qualified for Marble League 2020. They killed it at the first three events, but they lost it after the triathlon and fell back to fourth. They tried to get up higher on the podium, but they settled for 3rd.

The O'rangers were the best of the best, winning five gold, six silver, and three bronze. They continued on this streak until a shocking fail at 10th.


The Savage Speeders finished in at least 5th place every year. In 2021, they fell to 12th in the marble league.

Crazy Cat's Eyes had several lower end finishes and are now confirmed to be the hosts of Marble league and Marbula One after a show stopping victory at Marbula One.



The Best Brand Of Headphones

Wondering about the best brand of headphones? It's kinda complicated. For starters, there are two types of headphones --in-ear headphones and on/over ear headphones. When checking out headphones, look for a number and then Ohms or " Ω ." The more Ohms means they are harder to power. This means you need a big, expensive amp to experience the full potential of the headphones. Therefore, if you are in school, and need to use a iPad or Chromebook, I would recommend

the **Sony ZX Series On-Ear Headphones.** They sound OK for the roughly \$12.00 you would pay for them. They fold up for easy storage. The music sounds OK on them, but vocals are superb. If in-ears are your jam, the **Sony MDR-EX-15.** They are very high quality for being in-ears. Music, alongside vocals, also sound extremely good. Wanna go with Bluetooth? The top-pick for wireless headphones are the **JBL TUNE 500BT.** They have a very long playtime, as well as great sound although they aren't very comfortable for long term use. If you have a bit more money, and want great audio as well as a premium build, I would recommend the **AKG K92s**. They are very comfortable, sound great, and are easy to power. But the metal frame is prone to scratching. For you audiophiles out there, I would recommend the **Beyerdynamic DT-770 Pro 80 Ohm.** They also have a 32 Ohm version that is easy to power out of a phone.


