## Letter from Superintendent Ryan Rieber

#### Who's Packing Your Parachute?

Charles Plumb was a US Navy jet pilot in Vietnam. After 75 combat missions, his plane was shot down by a surface-to-air missile. Plumb was able to eject from the plane and parachute into the hands of the Vietnamese, where he survived six years in a communist Vietnamese prison. Years later, while out for dinner with his wife, a man at a neighboring table approached him and asked if he was Plumb. The man stated that he knew that Plumb was a pilot on the aircraft carrier Kitty Hawk and that he was shot down. When Plumb asked how he knew all this information about him, the man replied, "I packed your parachute." The man pumped his hand and said, "I guess it worked!"

As we transition into May, we are preparing to welcome another class of graduating Panthers into our community. The class of 2023 will complete their Senior Exit Projects on May 10th and then cross the stage in our high school gymnasium on Sunday, May 28th. High school graduation is a special rite of passage. When this group

of seniors looks back on high school, they can say they faced adversity and challenges yet experienced much success. The seniors persevered and successfully graduated as Panthers! 
