### The Importance of Mental Health

Last month, we received a visit from Dr. Jill Underly, State Superintendent of Schools at the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction as she spoke with some of our Pupil Services staff about the Stronger Connections Grant we re-

ceived through DPI. This grant has helped fund the addition of a school social worker in our district, a position that helps connect students and families to community resources and helps to advocate for them when they may be struggling, particularly with mental health issues. Dr. Underly spoke with our school social worker, as well as one of our students about the positive impact this role is having on our students and fam-





ilies, as well as how student and teacher mental health needs have changed throughout the years.

### What is Happening with the Construction Projects?



It's been an exciting few weeks around campus as dirt is moving and construction on the elementary school gym addition is underway! Contractors have begun excavation and students and staff alike are enjoying watching the projects begin.

#### **High School Addition and Renovation**

Design development for the high school addition and renovation projects is now over halfway done as we get closer to groundbreaking on this project. District leadership recently met to discuss technology and casework for all the spaces that are being impacted. The School Board continues to review the budget, and approved the second bid package for footings and foundation at their September 8th meeting.

Construction documents will be finalized for the high school renovation and addition after a full design review with District leadership. We are excited to announce that the groundbreaking for the high school projects will take place on Wednesday, October 8th at 3:00 p.m. at the rear of the high school. We invite all community members to join us as we begin the second phase of our project.

We are so thankful for the community support that has allowed us to provide these new spaces for our students and we can't wait to share more with you as the projects continue!


