

School Accountability Report

As part of the state accountability system, the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) produces report cards for every publicly funded school and district in Wisconsin. These Accountability Report Cards include data on multiple indicators for multiple years across four Priority Areas (Student Achievement, Growth, Target Group Outcomes, and On-Track to Graduation). In addition, given the impact on student success, the Accountability Report Cards also measure chronic absenteeism, graduation rates, postsecondary preparation, and arts course information. A school or district's Overall Accountability Score places the school/district into one of five Overall Accountability Ratings:
