### **Kindergarten**

No name needed on the following items:

- 3 packs of skinny Crayola brand crayons (24 count)
- 1 box Skinny Crayola markers
- 1 box Crayola Pipsqueek markers
- 1 Ziploc bags (girls-gallon, boys-snack)
- 1 box/bag of Healthy Snack - see list\*\*

### Optional

coffee filters, shaving cream, Q-Tips, baking soda

**Please mark your child's name on the following items:**

- 1 change of clothing (underwear, socks, pants and shirt) in a labeled Ziploc bag to be kept at school
- 1 very large, sturdy backpack  
(No wheels allowed) Needs to be able to hold folders, library books, snow pants from home, etc. When purchasing the backpack, make sure your child can open (zip, snap, etc.) the backpack.-SEE NOTE
- 1 pair of inexpensive tennis shoes to be left at school. Prefer Velcro. Purchase with growing feet in mind.- SEE NOTE
- 1 Beach towel (no substitutes) for rest time. (Towel to remain at school). No plastic mats.

- 1 sturdy PLASTIC pocket folder

- 1 pencil box or pouch
- 1 pair of good quality scissors (sharp ended)
- 1 12-pack Crayola colored markers
- 1 box Crayola twistable crayons (thick tip)
- 1 box/bag of Healthy Snack - see list\*\*
- 1 school bag or backpack - SEE NOTE
- 1 box Ziploc bags (girls-snack, boys-gallon)
- 1 pair inexpensive tennis shoes- SEE NOTE

**Grade 3**

- 1 8-count markers
- 1 pair of good quality scissors
- 1 school bag or backpack-SEE NOTE
- 1 pair inexpensive tennis shoes-SEE NOTE

**Grade 5**

- 4 sturdy pocket folders that go into a 3-ring binder
  - 1 1 1/2" binder with clear-view cover
  - 5 spiral notebooks (2 blue, red, green, yellow)
  - 1 3 subject notebook for Writing
  - 2 highlighters, each a different color
  - 2 sets colored pencils, 12 or 24 count
  - 1 pair quality scissors
  - 1 pkg of cap erasers or large eraser
  - 1 sturdy ruler, inch & centimeter markings (no flexi-rulers)
  - 1 large box facial tissue
  - 1 pencil pouch with 3-ring binder holes (No Boxes)
  - 2 boxes of 24 #2 pencils
  - 1 set of Post-it-Notes
  - 1 school bag or backpack
  - 2 jumbo glue sticks
  - 1 pkg red pens
  - 1 set of thin or thick markers
  - 1 pair of ear buds
  - 1 pk loose leaf paper

- 1 pencil pouch
- 1 pkg cap erasers
