Letter from Superintendent **Ryan Rieber**

Welcome Back!

Where did the summer go? It is hard to believe it's over, but it's also very exciting knowing that school is back in session. Even though students have been on campus in many different capacities throughout the summer, electricity is in the air when school is in session. We are excited that our students are in classrooms with our staff. providing the high-quality education we are proud of in West Salem. Preparations are complete, and we are collectively ready for an outstanding school year thanks to the support of our community!

Thank you for participating in our community feedback survey this past month. This will help the district gauge what our community, families, and staff desire. I also appreciate the number of comments that were provided. I am taking time and reading every one of those. Results will be made available to the public and posted on our website. I will also hold a discussion session to provide an overview of the results, listen to community feedback, and explain some of the thought process behind the

questions. Thank you again for your help!

The District completed many summer projects to prepare for the new school year. The most visible was the clean-up of the district facilities after the storm on July 28th. First, I hope you and your families are okay after the storm. It impacted many people residing in and around the school campus. I thank our maintenance crew for their time and effort in restoring our campus. Some of the more visible damage that occurred was fallen trees and fence damage. Other affected areas were our rubber roofs, the Panther Den roof, the soccer dugout roofs, damage to our aquaponics lab, and the solar panels on the top of the middle school. We have been working cooperatively with our insurance company and using the proper channels to repair the damage.

Among other projects this summer, we updated and improved the flooring in many of our second-floor classrooms at the high school. At the elementary school, we continued replacing carpeting with laminate flooring, and the middle school added some cupboards for storage

outside of our STEM labs. At our Outdoor Education Center, we added two park shelters to provide an educational learning space and shade for our students' visits. Solar Powered Learning

As they prepared for the upcoming school year, our middle school staff members participated in professional development with staff from the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point and Solar Connections to learn more

about the solar arrays on our middle school and how they can teach students about a variety of concepts using the system. Staff took a trip to the roof to view the panels, many of which were damaged during the recent storms, but will be replaced. Using thermal cameras, they could see where the panels were still generating energy and where the damage affected them. They learned how our various seasons affect the panels and the amount of energy they generate and they also ran through some simulations demonstrating how the sun powers the panels and creates electrons that work to generate energy. It was a great way for them to learn more about this innovative system and how they can incorporate lessons in the classroom!


