Letter from Superintendent Ryan Rieber serv

Ready for an Outstanding Year!

The District completed many summer projects and was ready for our students to walk back into our buildings for the first day of school. As we regularly do, we have been updating and improving areas of our campus over the summer. At the high school, we replaced the flooring in a second-floor hallway, updated flooring in the library, and updated some office spaces to open needed learning spaces for our increasing enrollment at the high school. At the elementary school, we continue to work on painting areas on the first floor to give a fresh update and we continued in some of our classrooms, replacing carpeting with a laminate floor. We also installed solar panels in our middle school through the contributions of a generous donor. Through this process, we have received questions on whether this has impacted our current roof's warranty. Before moving forward with the project, the District received a full go-ahead from our insurance company with the structure of the panels not voiding any of our remaining 20 years of warranty. This project will provide an excellent

service to our District and our community for years to come. The completion of these projects was a sure sign that school was starting!

The District welcomed guest speaker Curt Slater to our campus to kick off the year with our staff. Curt spoke to our staff from multiple perspectives, as he has held positions ranging from a paraprofessional to a high school principal within districts in Minnesota. He challenged us and encouraged our team to get better and not be bitter. He also spoke on how negativity permeates our society at all levels. As adult leaders, we must be professional and unbiased as we work with our children to make informed decisions. It was an excellent way for our staff to begin our school year.

Buddha once said, "No matter how hard the past is, you can always begin again." This year feels like a new beginning, and our staff has renewed excitement and eagerness as we welcomed our students back on Monday, August 29th. We began the school year early this year thanks to a requested waiver to the DPI that allowed us to start before September 1st. There is a renewed sense of purpose, relief, and optimism.
