Administering Non-Prescription Medication

Non-prescription medications, including, but not limited to:

Acetaminophen Imodium Dramamine Ibuprofen Benadryl TUMS

may be administered to students by the school nurse (or her designee) employed by the School District of West Salem with the written consent of the parent(s) or guardian(s).

Use of Defibrillator

AED may be used by school nurses or any other certified staff for cardiac arrest. Use pediatric defibrillator pads if available for students under age 8 or students who weigh less than 55 pounds.

Administration of Asthma Inhaler

Inhalers, such as Albuterol, are used to prevent and treat wheezing and shortness of breath caused by breathing problems such as asthma. Albuterol inhaler may be administered by school nurse or her designee to a student experiencing an emergency asthma attack.

Administration of Epi-Pen

Epinephrine 0.3 mg IM via Epi-pen may be administered by school nurses or her designee to a student experiencing an emergency allergic reaction.

Epinephrine 0.15 mg IM for students weighing 30-66 pounds may be administered by school nurse or her designee to a student experiencing an emergency allergic reaction.

Administration of Glucagon

Glucagon 1 mg IM may be administered by school nurse or her designee to a diabetic student experiencing an emergency LOW blood sugar.

Administration of an opiod antagaonist. Intra-Nasal Narcan

Naloxone via intra-nasal Narcan may be administered by school nurse or her designee to a student or persons who appear to be undergoing an opioid-related drug overdose emergency.
