

Student AI Use Expectations

Purpose:

These expectations aim to establish guidelines for the responsible and ethical use of AI tools in our learning environment. The use of AI can enhance our educational experience when used appropriately and with prior teacher approval. However, if used incorrectly, the use of these tools can severely limit the potential learning goals for students.

Guidelines:

1. Follow Teacher Expectations:

- For each task, your teacher will let you know what level of AI use is acceptable.
- If you are unsure whether AI is allowed in a particular assignment or activity, it is your responsibility to ask the teacher what AI tools, if any, are allowable.

2. Using AI Responsibly & With Integrity:

- AI can be a helpful tool, but it should not replace your own ideas and effort. Any work you turn in must be your own, and you should indicate AI was used to help. Using AI to cheat or copy is plagiarism and will be considered a violation of the school's academic honesty policy. AI should be a learning partner, not do the work for you.

3. Privacy and Data Security:

- Respect the privacy and data security of yourself and others when using AI programs. Do not share sensitive information or engage in any unethical activities.

4. Teacher Review:

- Any assessment and/or assignment is subject to a verbal review with the teacher. Be prepared to explain and discuss the content of your work, without the assistance of AI or reference to the assessment / assignment in question. Additional technology tools may be used to help determine if AI was used inappropriately. If you can not adequately represent your work, it may be determined that you have violated the district's academic honesty policy.
