Reminders from our Health Office:



Please continue to screen your child before in-person school and co-curriculars: Please keep your child home if they have <u>one</u> of the following symptoms: Cough, Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, New loss of taste or smell, or <u>two</u> the following: Congestion and runny nose, Headache, Fatigue, Muscle or Body Aches, Sore throat, Fever or chills, Nausea or vomiting, Diarrhea. (<u>school-age siblings will need to be excluded from school until the ill</u> <u>student has met the criteria</u>):

- Your child has a negative Covid-19 test, has had no fever without the use of fever-reducing medicines and has felt well for 24 hours. Documentation of the negative test must be provided to the school nurse. (wsnurses@wsalem.k12.wi.us)
 OR
- Your child receives confirmation of an alternative diagnosis from a healthcare provider, has had no fever without the use of fever-reducing medicines and has felt well for 24 hours. OR
- At least 10 days have passed since your child developed symptoms, your child has had no fever without the use of fever-reducing medicines and has felt well for 24 hours.

When we return to school, we will still continue to follow the La Crosse County Public Health and Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) guidance for schools, this includes following the 14 day quarantine for close contacts of a covid positive case. Please continue to use the one page "Attendance Guidelines" sheet for guidance on symptoms, isolation and quarantine.
