Date: October 28, 2020 Subject: Learning Mode Update

The School District of West Salem will be providing weekly updates on the COVID-19 condition in the County and the anticipated future learning modes for students. The School District will be using a <u>decision matrix</u> based upon the <u>Harvard Global Health Institute</u> and the <u>Minnesota Safe Learning Plan</u> to determine the mode of learning for students.

## **Future Mode of Learning**

The primary metrics show that we have moved into the RED category for this upcoming week as our West Salem Community numbers have increased. We will transition to back to virtual learning for all students 4K - 12. This also means that our co-curricular activities will be virtual with competitions postponed for the week of November  $2^{nd}$ .

The secondary metrics indicate the COVID-19 conditions in La Crosse County are also increasing. We will continue to monitor all our environment and will provide an update of our plans for the week of November 9<sup>th</sup> on Wednesday, November 4<sup>th</sup>. I will continue this communication on a weekly basis. Updates on both the community and county data can be found on our COVID-19 Dashboard. We will monitor the trend of the data and make an informed decision to try to get our students back on campus as soon as possible.

## Data

On Wednesday, October 28, 2020, the La Crosse County Health Department reported the following COVID-19 metrics and numbers that are used to aid the School District in determining the mode of learning:
