Date: November 4, 2020 Subject: Learning Mode Update

The School District of West Salem will be providing weekly updates on the COVID-19 condition in the County and the anticipated future learning modes for students. The School District will be using a <u>decision matrix</u> based upon the <u>Harvard Global Health Institute</u> and the <u>Minnesota Safe Learning Plan</u> to determine the mode of learning for students.

Future Mode of Learning

The primary metrics show that we remain the RED category for this upcoming week as our West Salem Community numbers continue to increase. We will remain in our virtual learning platform for all students 4K - 12. This also means that any co-curricular activities will be virtual with competitions postponed for the week of November 9th.

The secondary metrics indicate the COVID-19 conditions in La Crosse County are also continuing to increase. We will continue to monitor all our environment and will provide an update of our plans for the week of November 16th on Wednesday, November 11th. I will continue this communication on a weekly basis. Updates on both the municipality and county data can be found on our COVID-19 Dashboard. We will monitor the trend of the data and make an informed decision on try to get our students back on campus as soon as possible.
