

REPORTING STUDENT PROGRESS AND ACHIEVEMENTS TO PARENTS

The Board believes that parents/guardians should be made aware of student progress and achievement in the instructional program. Therefore, student progress and achievement reports shall be made to parents/guardians in accordance with the following:

Report Cards - Report cards shall be distributed at the conclusion of each academic grading period as determined by the building principal.

Parent Conferences/Open House Events - Formal parent conferences and/or open house events shall be held on a school-wide basis as determined by the building principal. Additional parent conferences may be held on a case-by-case basis anytime parents/guardians and staff deem necessary.

Additional Methods - Additional methods may be used to report student progress and achievement.
