

NUTRITION SERVICES MANAGEMENT

Students in the district shall have an opportunity to participate in school meal programs. These programs shall be administered by the superintendent and school nutrition director in accordance with established guidelines.

Food service prices shall be established by the Board annually. In accordance with federal guidelines, the district shall offer free and reduced price food services to students who qualify.

Each school shall keep accurate records of all meals served to students, milk served, meals served according to category (free, reduced and full priced meals) receipts of money, meals served to adults and other pertinent records.

The School District of West Salem shall not discriminate in school-sponsored food service programs on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
