

Naming School Facilities

The School Board may consider naming a facility or school. If named after a living or deceased individual, this individual should have exemplary moral character, made an outstanding contribution, or been of historical significance or performed service to the community or humanity, or displayed outstanding leadership.

Individuals seeking to honor such an individual must submit the name to the President of the School Board and statement of why such an individual should be so honored. The Board should then receive the request and hear from supporters at a regular board meeting.

Naming rights to facilities are not able to be purchased.

The Board has the right to withdraw this honor, if extenuating circumstances occur.
